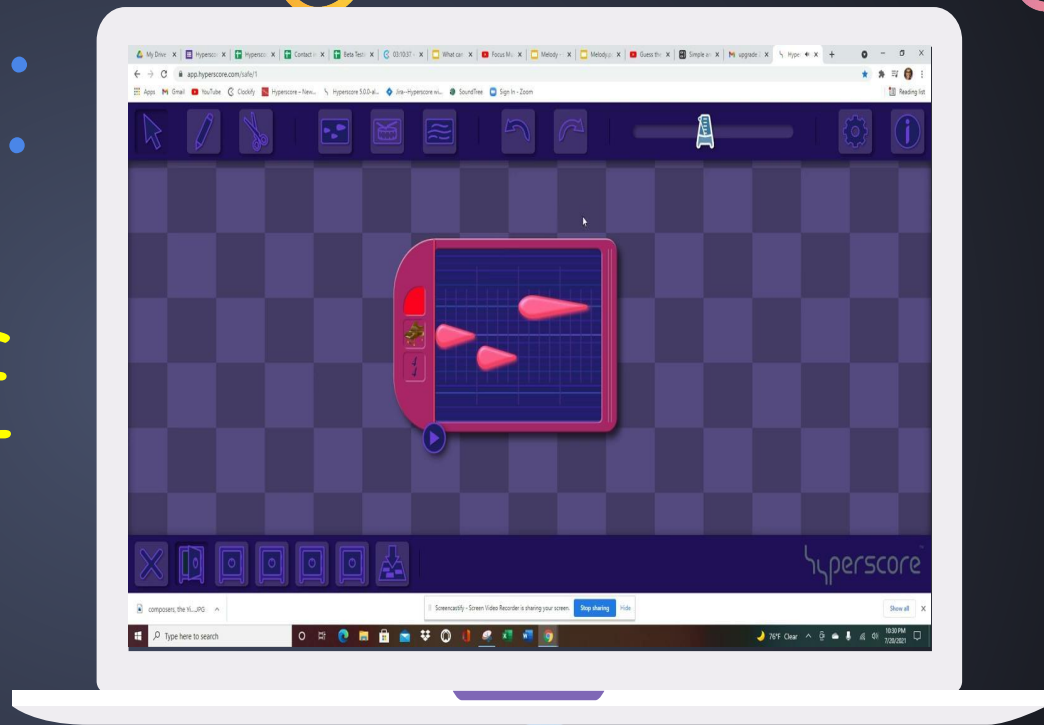

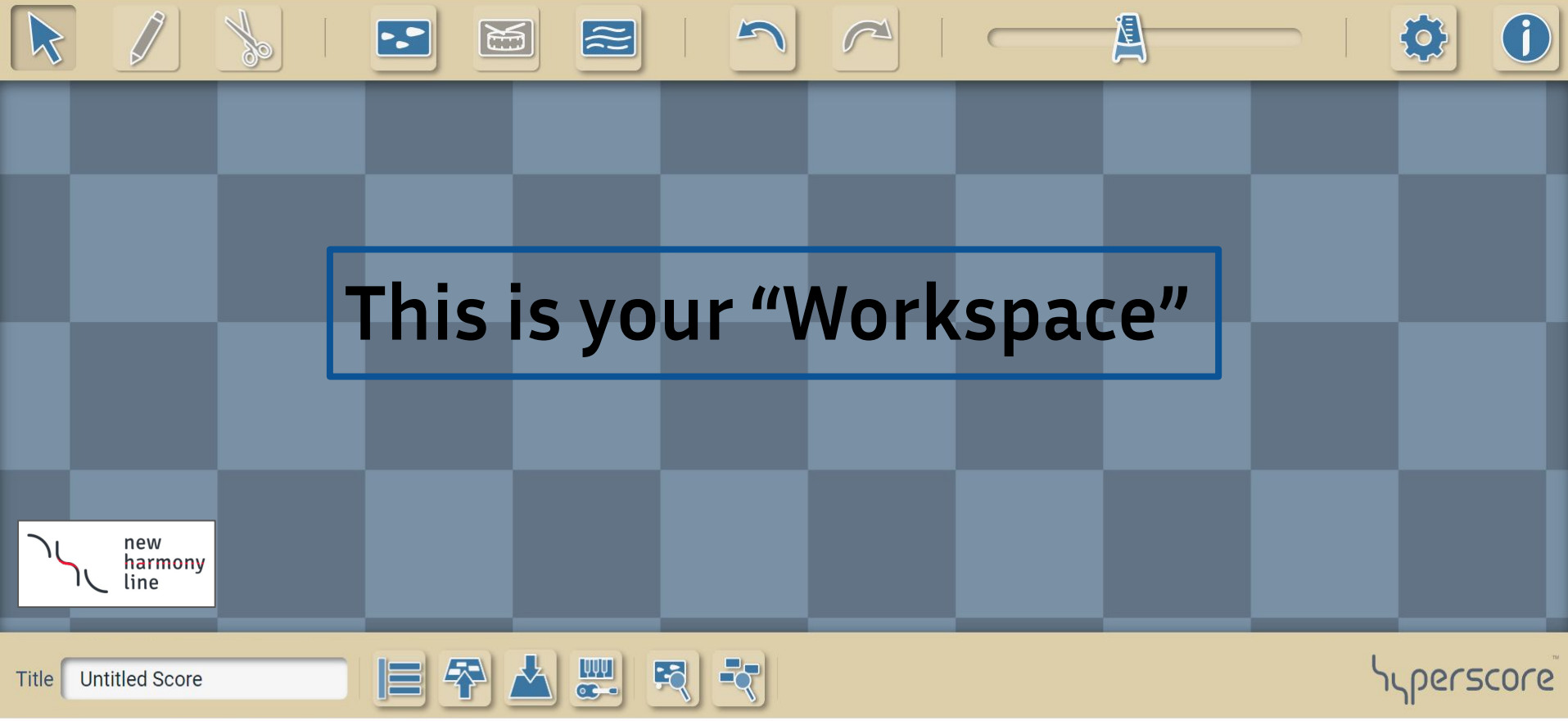


LET'S COMPOSE A MELODY



1. Open Hyperscore 5.0.



2. Click on the Melody Tool. Drop the icon anywhere on the Workspace and a Melody Window will appear.

Just like the Rhythm window, you can also add more measures to your Melody windows by pulling on the right side



You know the tools, so let's start composing a melody!!

1. Place your first note on the center line.

2. Make a melody I will recognize like "Hot Cross Buns" or "Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star" then call me over to see if your notes and values are correct.

3. Once I have recognized your melody, you need to make 1 to 2 more Melody Windows but they should be original. Edit until you like each melody!

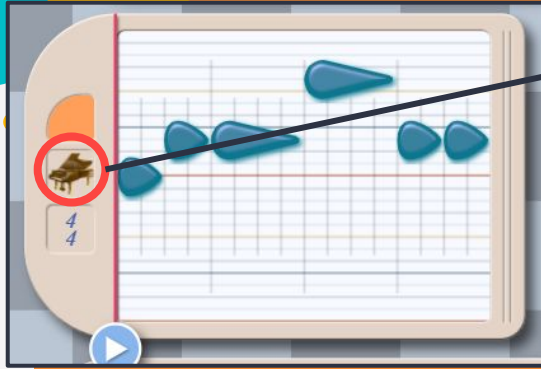

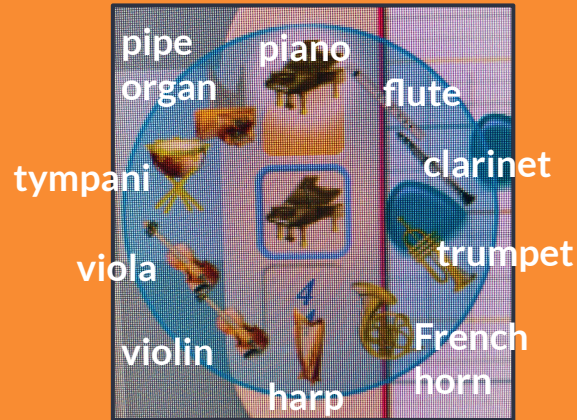

1. Click on the piano on the left side of the Melody Window



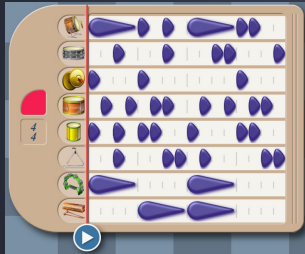
2. Run your mouse around the Tone Color wheel until you find the instrument you want OR keep the Tone Color PIANO

3. Play your melody to make sure you like the Tone Color you chose

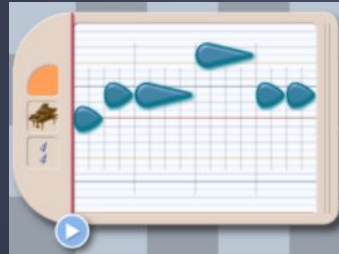
